The MLA style offers you an easy way to cite sources. An in-text citation names the source for the reader. It also gives the reader information to “locate the source in the list of works cited appearing at the end of the paper” (Anson and Schwegler 619). In-text citations for books include the name(s) of the author(s) and page number(s) of the material (Hoggatt and Shank 169).
