(Students in the state) April 1

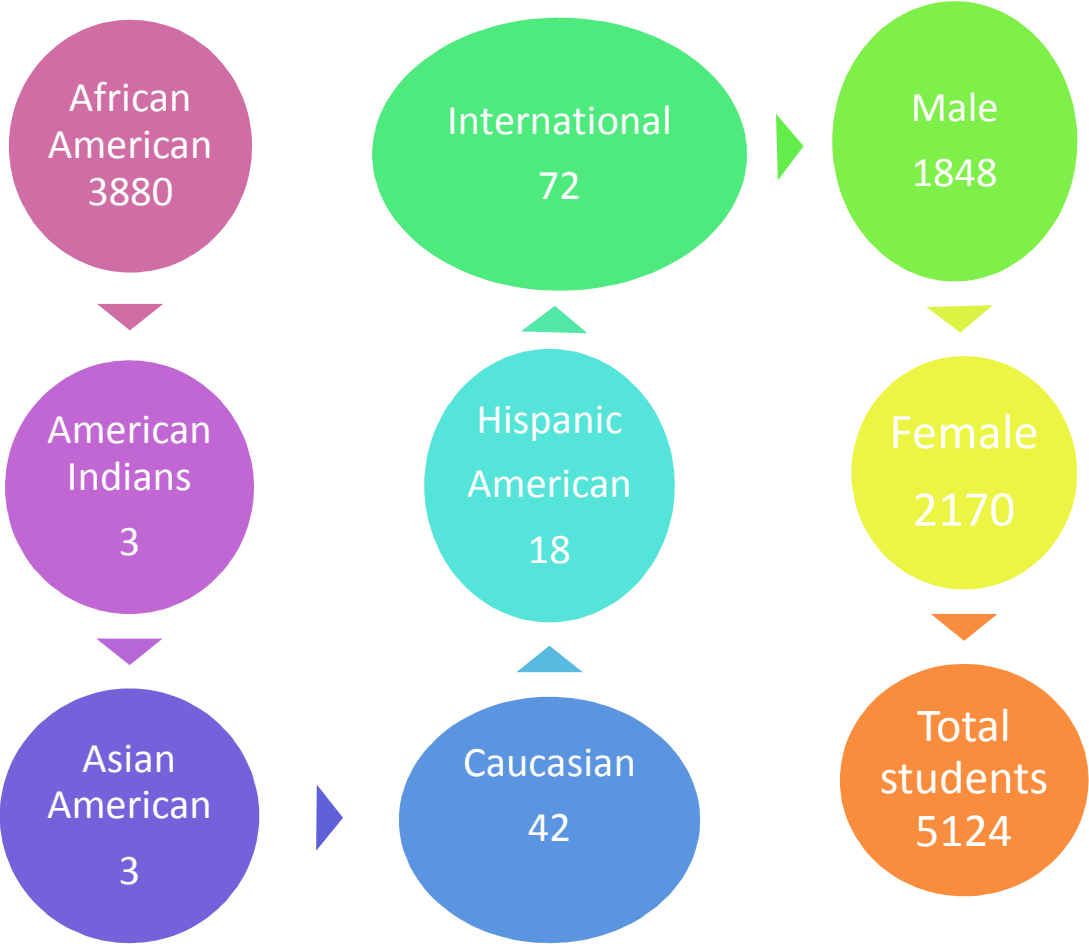
